INTER UNIT SPORTS DAY

A sports day for, four Cadet Units was held on Sunday 22 June 2008. The Inter-Unit sports day was inaugurated by Flying Officer Frericks in 2004 who along with Mrs Frericks donated a trophy.

In previous years only the three Wanganui Units participated. At the conclusion of the 2007 sports day a discussion was held to considering widening the day to include all the units in the Wanganui – Manawatu area.

All seven units were invited to participate with 28 June being the date. This was changed to 22 June due to a Range Safety Officers Course being conducted at Ohakea over the weekend 27-28 June.

The two Manawatu Cadet Corps Units were unable to attend with the change in date and the three Wanganui Units along with No.32 Squadron (Feilding) ATC participated on the day.

LOCATION

The sports day was held at Wanganui High School using the netball, volleyball and indoor basketball courts. The use of Wanganui High Schools facilities provides the opportunity to hold the netball, volleyball and soccer indoors should the weather not allow any sports to be played outdoors.

PERSONNEL

The umpiring and referring was undertaken by a number of people including some cadets where it was known they had the necessary skills. Mrs Grant and Mrs Beard were the two main netball umpires and they were assisted by Cadet Whiteman the netball.

DAY ACTIVITIES

Near the end of the second half of round 3 the weather deteriorated. We managed to finish this round before heading off to the gymnasium. Rounds of Volleyball and Indoor Soccer were held before lunch, with the remaining rounds held after lunch.

The Touch Rugby was not held due to the rain falling and the grounds not suitable nor safe for playing on.

The trophy presentation was held, area checked and all personnel departed.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The expansion to include the Manawatu Units was successful, even though only No.32 Squadron could participate this year and all the units should be invited to participate in 2009.

Consideration should be given to a 4th indoor activity if the weather does not allow for touch rugby to be played.

The 4 sports of netball, volleyball, soccer (indoor this year) and touch provide a range to which all cadets can participate in.

If the weather allows both soccer and touch could be played at the same time and 2 games of volleyball could be played using Wanganui High Schools facilities.
